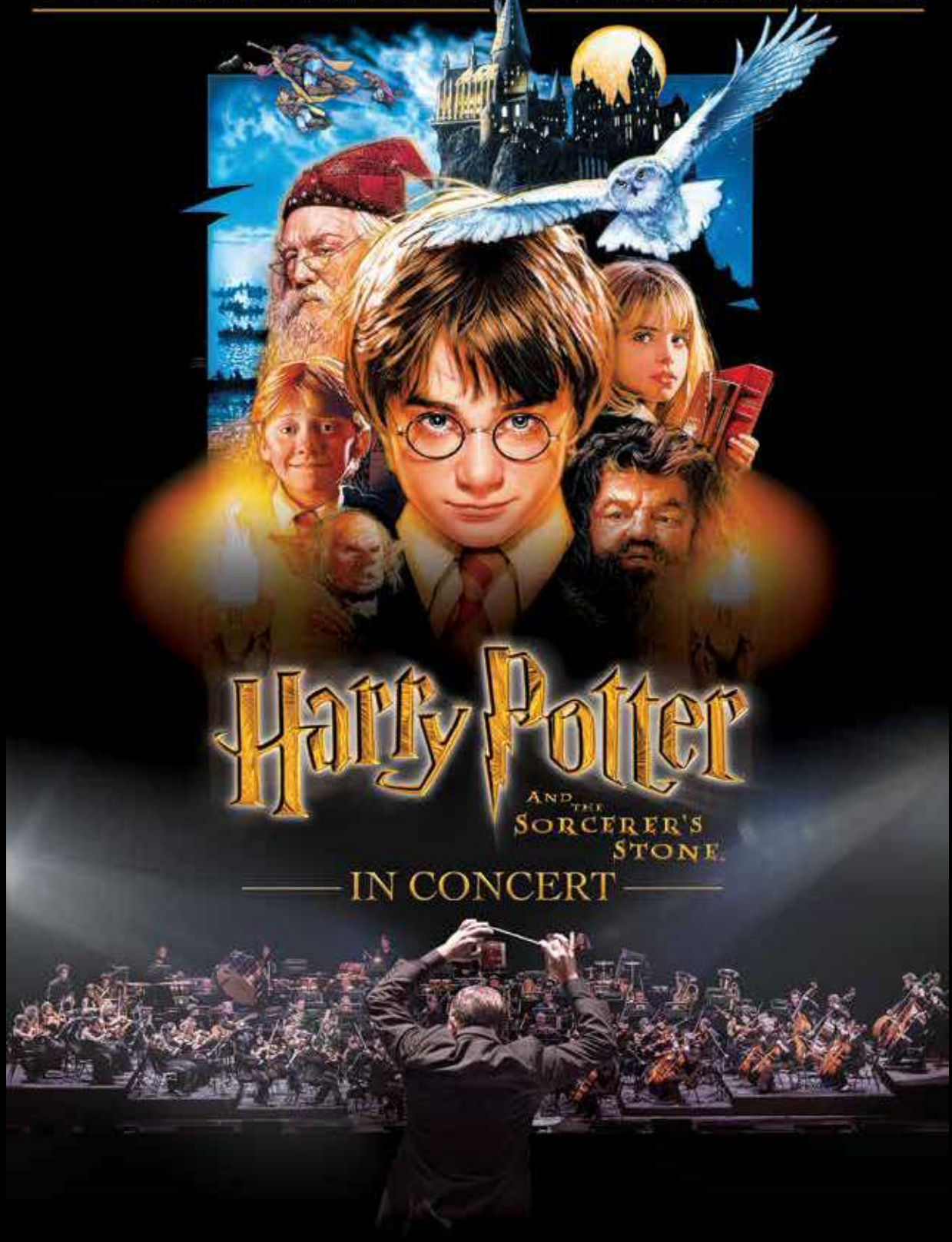

COMPOSER

John Williams



In a career spanning more than six decades, John Williams has become one of America's most accomplished and successful composers for film and the concert stage. He remains one of our nation's most distinguished and contributive musical voices. He has composed the music for more than one hundred films, including all nine Star Wars films, the first three Harry Potter films, Schindler's

List, E.T. the Extra-Terrestrial, Jaws, Jurassic Park, Saving Private Ryan, Lincoln, Close Encounters of the Third Kind, Superman and the Indiana Jones films. He served as music director of the Boston Pops Orchestra for fourteen seasons and remains their Laureate Conductor. He has composed numerous works for the concert stage including two symphonies and more than a dozen concertos commissioned by some of America's most prominent orchestras. He has received five Academy Awards and fifty-four Oscar nominations, seven British Academy Awards, twenty-five Grammys, four Golden Globes, and five Emmys. His other honors include the Kennedy Center Honors, the National Medal of Arts, an honorary KBE from Queen Elizabeth II, the Life Achievement Award from the American Film Institute, Spain's Princess of Asturias Award for the Arts, and the Gold Medal from the UK's prestigious Royal Philharmonic Society.

Thomas Wilson is one of today's most versatile and dynamic musicians, celebrated as a conductor, composer, orchestrator, and trumpeter. His extensive catalog of works and arrangements has been performed worldwide, creating new opportunities for orchestras and artists alike. His orchestrations have been heard with the Philadelphia Orchestra, the Gothenburg Symphony, and dozens of other ensembles.

As Associate Conductor of the Colorado Springs Philharmonic, Thomas leads nearly half the season across Pops, Classical, and educational concerts, and often joins the trumpet section when not on the podium. He also serves as Music Director of the Chamber Orchestra of the Springs, transforming it into one of the nation's most vibrant chamber ensembles. Under his leadership, the orchestra has earned national recognition for bold, and diverse programming.

Education is at the heart of Thomas's work. He has conducted the Colorado Springs Youth Symphony, founded the Young Concert Artists Orchestra, and continues to mentor young musicians as a guest conductor, clinician, and faculty member at Colorado College and the Colorado Springs Conservatory.

Equally at home in the concert hall, theater, or opera house, Thomas has collaborated on countless projects in dance, film, and stage. Recent productions such as *Blind Injustice* and *Glory Denied* highlight his dedication to making the arts vital and relevant to contemporary audiences.

A summa cum laude graduate of the University of Northern Colorado, where he received the School of Music's highest honor, Thomas also holds a master's degree in Conducting from Colorado State University. He has studied with leading mentors including Lawrence Leighton Smith, Gustav Meier, and Michael Tilson Thomas, who described him as "someone to watch." Away from the podium, Thomas is a lifelong learner and adventurer. He is a voracious reader, a classic car enthusiast, and happiest exploring Colorado trails with his beloved dog, Ella.
